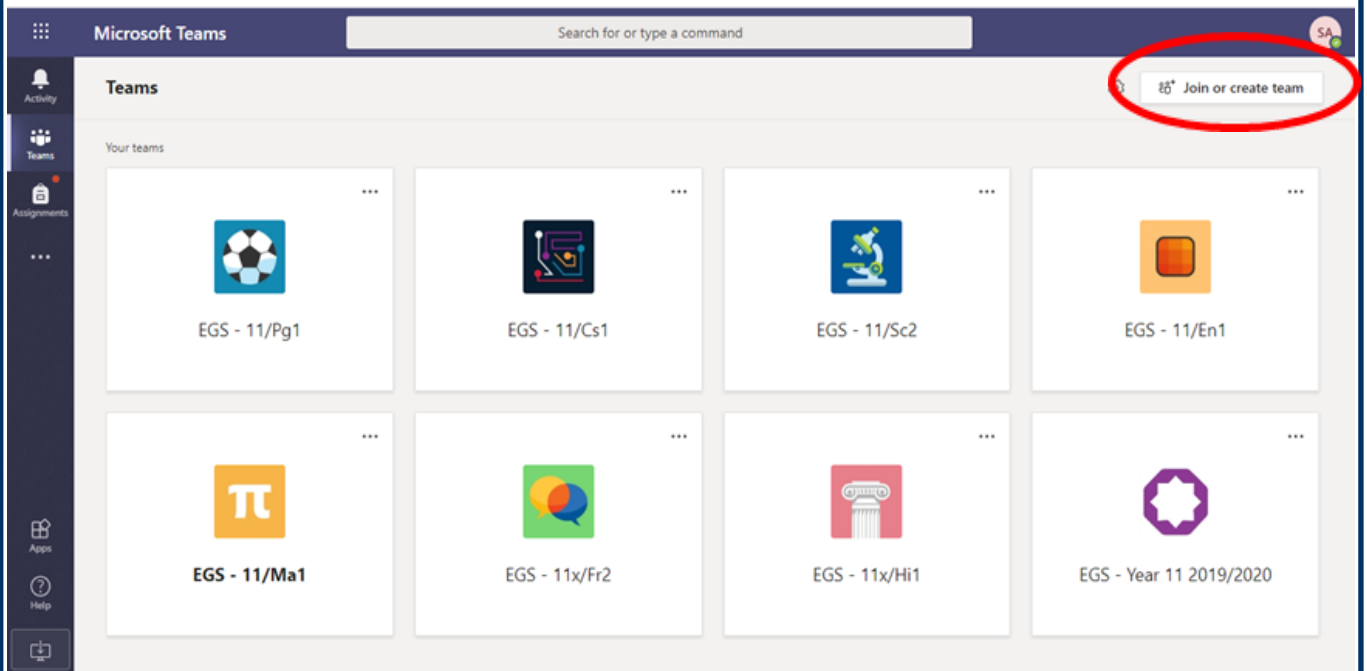

How to login to TEAMS:

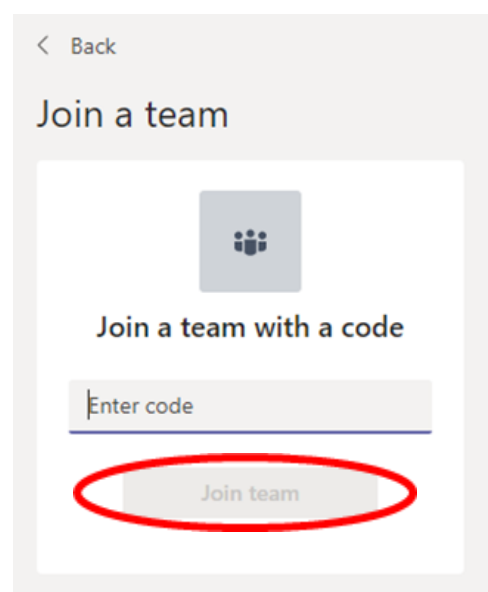
Once logged into Teams, To put in the code, click join or create a team button in the top right hand corner, circled in red.



Once you click the button, this menu appears.

Enter the code **tx8g4r8** and click the join team button circled. Be careful when inputting your team code, all the letters are lower case.

When you are logged in...we will ask you to press mute (if needed....depends how many join).

Achievements out of school

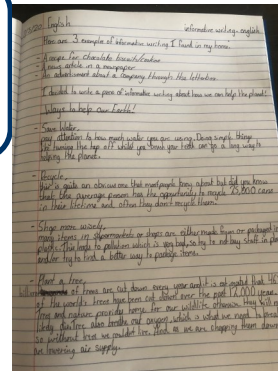
We are very proud of Ben who has been selected for the LTA's top support programme for junior wheelchair players.

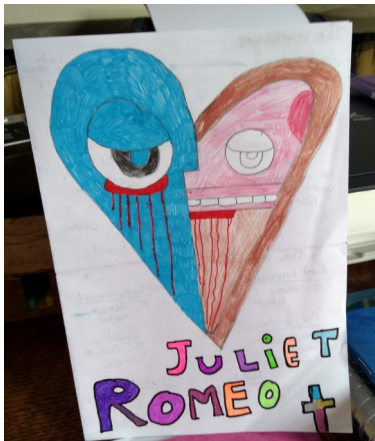

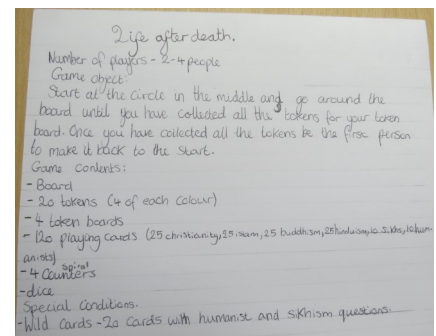

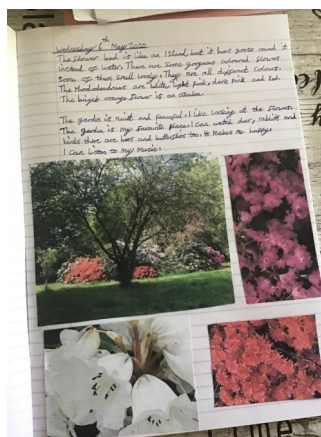
