#### **Reminders**

- **Absence**: Please call the school office before 8.30am if your child is not coming in for any reason. If your child travels to school by taxi, you need to contact the taxi firm directly.
- **Mobile Phones**: All mobile phone and tablet devices must be handed to the office for safeguarding reasons. They can then be collected at the end of the day.

## **Construction College starts on Thursday 17 September**


⇒ please remember your steel toe cap boots and overalls
