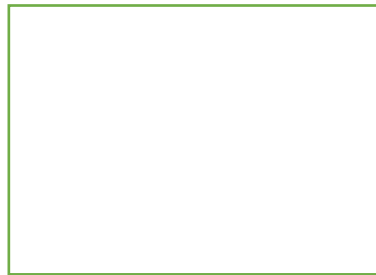


My parents or carers are deputy teachers during Lockdown!

My name is _____ and I usually go to All Saints School in Lessingham.

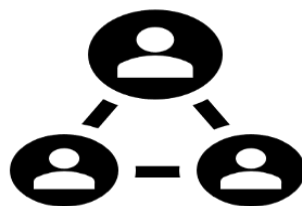
