Dear Parents and Carers,

In September, we will be changing the structure of the school for Years 7, 8 and 9. Our pupil voice surveys since last March have shown that our students have enjoyed having their own 'base' where they feel safe and secure and where they can have their belongings around them. We have also found that being tied to our current timings of 40mins lessons can restrict teachers who wish to explore ideas in more depth, take learning outside of the classroom or adapt lessons and learning to the needs of the students.

Our plan is to have 5 classes across KS2 and KS3 (years 3-9 inclusive), each class will have a class teacher and at least 1 TA. Lower juniors, upper juniors, year 7, 8 and 9 teachers will be responsible for delivering a curriculum that is appropriate to the needs of the students, sufficient in breadth and depth, and incorporating the interventions needed to meet the outcomes in the individuals' EHCP. Lessons will be one hour in length and the structure of the day will be as follows:

KS3 class teachers will be able to teach the planned curriculum and interventions using a practical approach that suits the majority of the learners of our school. We will still have our specialist teachers available to ensure that there is sufficient challenge for those students that require it. I am very excited about the model for September.

We have recruited three super class teachers who will join our wonderful team:

- ❖ Year 7 - Ms Nicky Austin who will be supported by Ms Gemma Montgomery
- ❖ Year 8 - Mr Jack Hayes who will be supported by Ms Hampton and Mrs Parameter
- ❖ Year 9 - Ms Sian Jones who will be supported by Miss Pinsent and Miss Armstrong
