In this letter you will find details of the new mathematics system and scheme we are implementing in school; which we hope will ensure all pupils are able to progress and flourish in their mathematics learning.

The new scheme will be followed by all pupils in Key Stage 2 and 3, which we hope will allow you to support your child's learning by being aware, assisting with homework or just having a conversation with your child about what they are doing at school. Here is an overview of topics which will be taught over the year:

Within each topic, all pupils will be working at a stage appropriate to their ability, to allow them to access the mathematics right for them, to be able to progress. There are six stages across Key stage 2 and 3 and all pupils will be allocated their stage at the beginning of each topic, as we are aware that mathematical ability can vary across the different topics. Therefore, depending on the topic, you may find your child working in a different group depending upon which stage is appropriate, however, be assured this will allow us to focus teaching and enable them to achieve success.

We are aware that pupils being taught together by mathematical understanding (at a stage) rather than age, maybe a new model to you, however we would like to reassure you that we believe this is the best way to nurture your child's learning and achieve success in this important subject.
