Natalie Outred and PC Jennings from the Children and Young people's team at Norfolk Constabulary will be delivering a presentation to Year Nine on 'Healthy Friendships and Grooming' on Thursday 23rd June your child's school. This year group has been chosen to have this delivery in accordance with supporting the school in delivering its PSHE which provides the social learning to the students. The aim of this session is to aid safeguarding the students by enhancing their knowledge around these topics.

The session will include learning about what a healthy friendship looks like, we will cover different types of bullying and the consequences. We will discuss briefly the concept of consent. Finally, we will discuss Grooming, this will include a couple of case studies to look at and a video. The sessions will also have accompanied tutor time material for teachers on Consent, and Internet grooming which they will be able to access according to the needs of their pupils.
