Dear Parent/guardian

Paul Johnson from the Children and Young people's team at Norfolk Constabulary will be delivering a presentation to Year 10 on 'Relationship Abuse' at your child's school. This year group has been chosen to have this delivery in accordance with supporting the school in delivering its PSHE which provides the social learning to the students. The aim of this session is to aid safeguarding the students by enhancing their knowledge around this topic and prepare them for adulthood.

The session will include learning what a healthy intimate relationship looks like, we will discuss the negative sides of relationships including domestic abuse. We will talk about the law around sexual consent. Will also discuss where they can take their concerns both now and in the future as adults. The sessions will also have accompanied tutor time material for teachers on domestic abuse – violence, respecting boundaries and control which they will be able to access according to the needs of their pupils.
