Did you know?

- Using the library to borrow books and use the computers is free for everyone.
- Reading at home makes a big difference to how well children get on at school and after school – children who read more succeed more!
- Everyone who joins the library can borrow up to 15 books at any one time; and you can download eBooks and audiobooks for free too!
- From coding, crafting, LEGO building and learning, your local library is a great way to explore new skills, make new friends and discover a new world of exciting books.

Your child's class will be visiting the library soon to find out how to use the library and borrow books. If your child already has a library card and you and their class teacher are happy to let them borrow some books, then please make sure they bring it with them on the day.

If your child hasn't joined the library yet, if their card has been lost, or if their card has not been used for a long time, please fill in and return the accompanying joining form to your child's teacher before their visit to the library, so we can update their account or give them a library card on the day. Please ensure you complete all parts of the form.

If you prefer, your child can be offered a Lite membership, so that a maximum of 2 books can be borrowed at one time. This can be changed to a full membership at any time by popping into your local library and speaking to a member of staff.
