**IMPORTANT INFORMATION**  
**Human Papillomavirus (HPV) immunisation**

**The Immunisation Team are coming to All Saints School on **Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> June** to offer 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> doses of the HPV vaccine to students in Year 8 and above.**

The HPV vaccination helps protect boys and girls from HPV-related cancers. This virus increases the risk of developing some cancers later in life, such as cervical cancer, some mouth and throat cancers and some cancers of the anus and genital areas.

In line with the National Immunisation Programme, Hertfordshire Community NHS Trust's School Aged Immunisation Service offers the HPV vaccination to all eligible boys and girls in year 8 and in addition to this, those in year 9 or older who have missed their vaccination due to the COVID pandemic will also be seen in school.

Please make sure on the day of immunisations your child is fit and well and encourage them to eat breakfast.

**A response is required. (if not already given) You must accept or decline this vaccination by completing the online form**
