Our KS4 curriculum comprises both access to GCSE outcomes (level 2) and the opportunity to achieve an alternative qualification being available at level 2, level 1 or entry level.

Based on the capacity and subject specialisms within our staff, the subjects below will be available for students to study. Our students are supported to build their confidence, achieve personal goals and attain the skills, knowledge and understanding to underpin exam success and progress to further education and employment.

It is expected that all students will study the core subjects and choose a maximum of three foundation subjects. PSHEE, RSE and Physical Education (PE) will also continue to be taught in order to support students prepare for an independent adult life and remain active.
