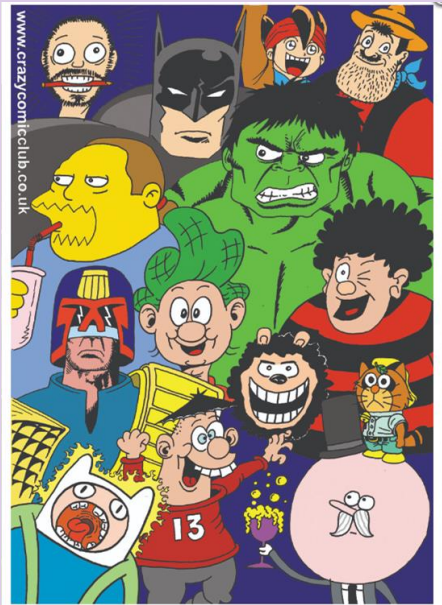
This year to celebrate World Book Day we welcome James Parsons, online, from the Crazy Comic Club.

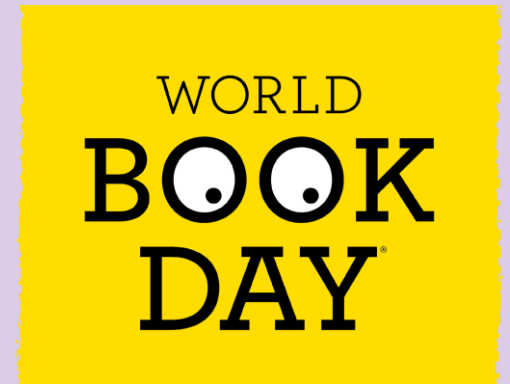

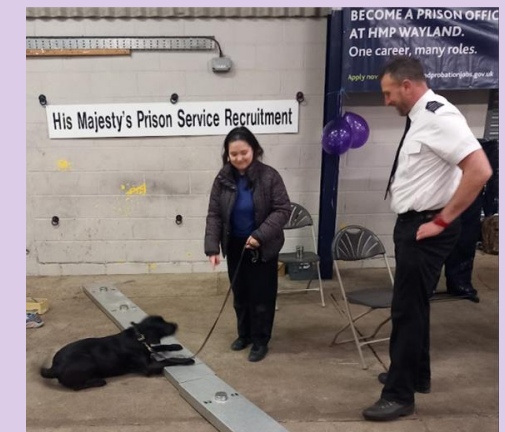

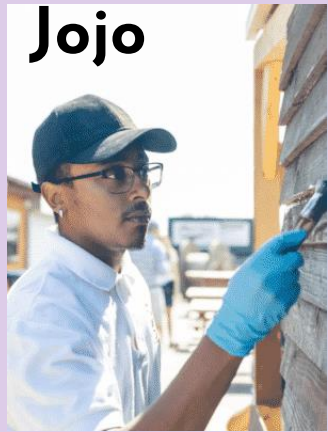

ACROSS

- The feeling or belief that one can have faith in or rely on oneself.
- The knowledge and ability that enables you to do something well.
- The ability and willingness to change one's general working pattern or idea.
- The general knowledge of business, business experiences (or work experience) and understanding of the industry which they work.

DOWN

- The objective analysis and evaluation of an issue in order to form a judgement.
- The ability to use your time, energy, resources, etc. in an effective way so that you achieve the things you want to achieve.
- Being able to handle numbers in an appropriate way.
- The process of finding solutions to difficult or complex issues.
- The ability to assess and initiate things independently.
- The use of imagination or original ideas to create something or approach a problem in a different way, inventiveness.
- The imparting or exchanging of information by speaking, writing, or using some other method.
- Being able to use common computer packages.
- Cooperation between those who are working on a task.
- The skills required to search for answers to questions, to construct reasoned argument or theories based on evidence and to increase understanding in a particular field of inquiry.
