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# MESSAGE FROM THE HEADTEACHER

We have had an amazing two weeks in school and as a school family we have experienced a range of emotions. During the Year 11 leavers assembly we had tears of *happiness* as we looked at photographs and videos of moments from the past and tears of *sadness* as we waved them all goodbye from school for the last time. We experienced *Elation*, as the ASDAN group won GOLD at the Norfolk Show in the small garden category. *Joy*, *happiness* and *enjoyment* at the Summer Fayre along with maybe a little *disappointment* if we didn't win a prize at the raffle or tombola. For some there was *fear* on the climbing wall, *pride* seeing art work displayed or *frustration* if we didn't score a goal or get the basketball through the hoop. We are all *tired* as we approach the end of term and for some there is *excitement*, but for most *anxiety* about the changes in class teachers as we move classrooms ready for next week's transition week.

As a school we use the Zones of Regulation to help us learn about different emotions and to understand how our emotions affect us and impact on others. In the new academic year, we will be refreshing our use of the Zones of Regulation approach and providing additional time to explain to students the All Saints expectations. We will be providing you with more information of this from September.

I want to thank each and every one of you for your support – your positive comments and thanks, these help myself and every member of the staff team give 100% day in day out to ensure your young person gets the very best opportunities at All Saints School.

I look forward to finishing the academic year together at Ingham Church at 1:30pm on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July – where I can guarantee we will experience even more emotions!
