Hello parents and carers for year 11 students. We are so very glad to welcome year 11 back and excited for what this summer term holds for them.

As well as the challenge of exam season there is planning underway for their activities week and work experience so it will be a very exciting as well as demanding term.

#### **Maths**

After Easter we will be focusing on revision of all Maths topics and practising past paper questions for the exam entry (either GCSE or Entry Level) which students are sitting.

In lessons we are now carrying out the final revision and preparation for the GCSE English exams. As well as this we will finalise the last of the Unit Awards that some students are undertaking in this subject.

We will be adapting our final lessons to address areas where students feel they need more support and really refine our exam skills.

#### **Science**

This half-term Year 11 will be finishing the GCSE course; we just have the final Chemistry topic, Chemical Analysis, to do. We will then be doing some focussed revision, using a range of methods and resources.

Everyone has been given an exam preparation sheet, showing what will be on each Science exam. This also includes suggestions for different revision methods.
