Norfolk Constabulary have organized the delivery of our new educational resource "Your Choice Matters" at your child's school on the Tuesday 23rd of September.

This session is about knife crime and students will learn about the law around carrying weapons and the impact of knife crime on individuals and the wider community. There will be opportunities for them to discuss a range of issues by completing tasks in small groups. We aim to make children better informed about both the legal and emotional consequences of knife crime and increase their awareness of where they can go and who to speak to if they have concerns about this subject.
