We wanted to get in touch again and let you know our plans for the second part of the Spring half term. The Year 6 team are looking forward to another successful, exciting and busy half term.

If you would like to support your child's learning at home, we thought it would be helpful for you to have a more detailed idea of what we are learning about.

Students are also given 2 pieces of optional homework a week, and spellings. Each completed piece of homework will receive 3 house points. Homework is linked to the topics they are learning about.

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at the topic of Fractions, Decimals and Percentages. Students will continue to work on Maths in the groups that provide them with the right amount of challenge and support. Students are able to practice their times tables using TTRockstars (the link is included below)

English

In English this term, the students will be creating their own mythological stories, using descriptive language to develop thrilling plots, characters and settings, before introducing a flashback as a structural technique to develop their story writing. We will be visiting the Puppet Theatre in Sheringham to create a Mythical character and act out a story in their puppet theatre

SPAG

Students will learn how to use fronted adverbials, conjunctions, speech punctuation, expanded noun phrases whilst writing their Greek myth.

Geography

In this unit - called Local Study - students will use fieldwork to observe, measure, record and present the human and physical features in the local area using a range of methods including sketch maps, plans, graphs and digital technologies.

Science

During Spring term part two, the Upper Juniors will be learning about fossil formation and conducting an investigation to develop skills around working scientifically, which will be taught by Miss Wade.

Mrs Urry will be investigating the properties and changes of materials. Students will learn how to identify different materials based on their physical properties and will learn about testing materials to discover reversible and irreversible changes.

Computing

This unit looks at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. Pupils use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data. They create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems. They use a real-life database to answer a question, and present their work to others.
