Dear Parents and Carers

We are delighted to share that we have once again been invited back to Willow Farm, and we are very much looking forward to taking our Junior students on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2026 for an afternoon of hands-on learning linked to agriculture, wildlife and the local environment. Below is an outline of the visit so you are aware of the structure of the afternoon.

### **Visit Schedule**

- 12.30pm: Arrival at Willow Farm and introduction
- 12.30pm–1.30pm: Group activities in the Barn, including a farm machinery demonstration, crop-themed learning, interactive displays, and wildlife exploration
- 1.30pm–1.45pm: Toilet stop in the yard area
- 1.45pm–2.50pm: Trailer trip with commentary, travelling down Hill Common and past Hickling Broad to explore crops, the flower meadow and the old boathouses.
- The route continues onto Stubb Road to see the cattle and woodland on the marshes, with time for bug hunting using sweep nets and pots (if time allows).
- 2.55pm: Depart Willow Farm and return to school

Students will remain with staff throughout and will rotate through all activities.

As a gentle reminder, suitable footwear and long trousers are advisable, as students will be walking through farm areas and long grass (PE uniform is ideal) with either trainers, boots or wellies.

We would also like to make parents aware that ticks can be present in the countryside at this time of year, so we recommend that you check your child after the visit, just in case.
